Patient Education Material.

The Mayo Clinic patient education library gives health care providers access to educational aids for patient treatment plans. Patient education content gives staff a way to share essential information with at-risk patients or preventive information that will help patients live healthier lives.

Truven healthcare education is also provided to patients throughout their stay.

Mayo Clinic's patient education library features 2,500 pieces of material in English, with some library offerings also available in Spanish. Most of the content is written at a sixth-grade reading level.

Who has access to Mayo Clinic's patient education library?

Summit Healthcare providers have direct access to the patient education library. Providers may only use Mayo Clinic's patient education material for Summit Healthcare patients.
