Archived Mayo Clinic Grand Rounds.

Grand Rounds events provide opportunities for clinical practitioners, physicians and faculty to share medical successes and challenges, and guest lecturers to provide important national and international context regarding the growing challenges and opportunities in the science of health care delivery. Grand Rounds include 45- to 60- minute presentations with opportunities for *0.75 to 1.0* AMA PRA Category 1 CME Credit(s)*TM.

Current offerings include: Cardiology, Center for Individualized Medicine, Clinical and Translational Science, Infectious Disease, Internal Medicine, Neurology, Nurse Practitioners and Physicians, Nursing, Patient Education, and Psychiatry and Psychology.

If I am a Summit Healthcare physician, how do I claim CME credit?

Mayo Clinic Grand Rounds that are available for CME credit are accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education to provide continuing medical education for physicians. Mayo designates this enduring material for a maximum of 0.75 or 1.0" *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)*TM. Eligible physicians should only claim credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

Following the Mayo Clinic Grand Rounds video, a link is provided to take a post-test to verify participation, evaluate the activity, claim credit, and obtain a certificate. The eligible physician is required to pass the test with a score of 80% or greater, with up to one re-take allowed.
