Observation and participation in eTumor Board Conferences is only available to Summit Healthcare physicians who have signed a conditions for participation. Summit Healthcare physicians are encouraged to serve in an observatory role for at least two (2) eTumor Board sessions before presenting a case. eTumor Board case submissions for Lung, Genitourinary, Breast, and Colorectal Conferences must be submitted at least one (1) week prior to the desired eTumor Board. Case submissions for Lymphoma Conferences must be submitted at least two (2) weeks prior to the eTumor Board Conference. Some exceptions may apply.

# **STEP 3** Provide additional supporting information to accompany the one-page Clinical Summary.

Your assigned clinical integration specialist in the Quality Improvement Department will help compile the supporting information.

- Imaging
- Pathology
- ▶ Language
- Labs Send labs dated within the most recent six months only. No labs> six months.
- \* Please send high-quality images and reports only.

### How will I know if my case was selected for an eTumor Conference?

Your clinical integration specialist will notify you, via your preferred method of contact, if your eTumor Board case was selected to be presented. Please note that Mayo Clinic selects which case submissions will be presented.

### Are there, any presentation specifications?

The requesting provider must present the case using PowerPoint the day of the eTumor Board. The goal is to "tell the patient story" in three minutes or less. A template is provided on the network member website http//corenetworkmembers.mayoclinic.org/member-services/etumorboards
