




About Summit Healthcare

Show Low, Arizona is a growing community with four beautiful seasons that create the perfect playground for year-round outdoor activities.

Located approximately an hour away from Show Low, Sunrise Ski Resort is Arizona's largest ski resort, offering skiing, snowboarding, ski bikes, and lessons for all ages.

Location Demographics

- Show Low is the largest city in the White Mountains and is one of the fastest growing cities in northern Arizona. The city proper has a population of nearly 12,000+ residents and more than doubles in size during the summer season.
- Show Low is located approximately 3 hours northeast of Phoenix, 2 hours southeast of Flagstaff, and 4 hours north of Tucson.
- 6,500 Feet Elevation / 4 seasons
- Wildlife common to the area includes deer, elk, bear, antelope, mountain lion and turkey. There are over 2 million acres of National Forest land adjacent to Show Low and over 40 lakes and streams in the immediate area.
- The Coconino National Forest is home to the largest stand of Ponderosa Pine trees in the world. It is one of six National Forests in Arizona and covers 1.8 million acres of varied landscape and elevation.
